

Apple Developer Account Set-Up

In order to create an Apple developer account, the first step is to [create](#) an Apple ID. If you already have an existing Apple ID, proceed to this [page](#).

A basic Apple developer account costs 99 USD per membership year. You have three enrolment options:

1. Individual / Sole Proprietor / Single Person Business

You would need:

- Apple ID
- Basic personal information, including your legal name and address.

Required fields:

- Contact information (Legal Name, Phone, Address)

- Your organization must be a legal entity so that it can enter into contracts with Apple. We do not accept DBAs, fictitious businesses, trade names, or branches.

Required fields:

- Verification contact if you aren't owner or founder (First name, Last Name, Job Title, Business email, Phone).
- Organization Information (Legal Entity Name, D-U-N-S number, Website, Phone, Work Email)

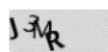

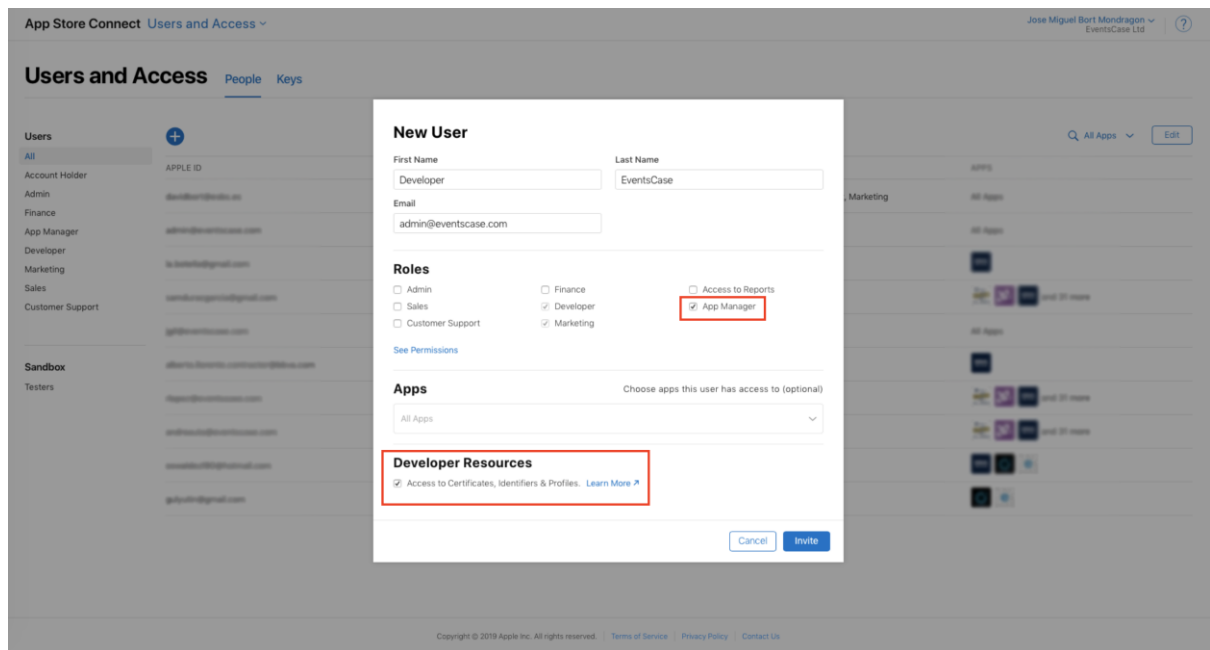

EventsCase Binding
